Rule 306. Table A9. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m. DRAWN ORDER

Prize Money: 1st-£250, 2nd-£200, 3rd-£150, 4th-£100, 5th-£50 Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members.

Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (eg. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

2 SENIOR NEWCOMERS FIRST ROUND / SENIOR 1.10m OPEN

Rules 312. Single Phase. Speed 325 mpm. Start Height 1.10m. DRAWN ORDER Prize Money: 1st-£75, 2nd-£40, 3rd-£37.50, 4th-£27.50, 5th-£25, 6th-£20 In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld.

Newcomers: a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2018, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Newcomers Second Round qualifying period for the 2024 second rounds is 1 May '23 – 30 April '24 (subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

3 SENIOR FOXHUNTER FIRST ROUND / SENIOR 1.20m OPEN

Rule 310. Table A7. Speed 350 mpm. Start Height 1.20m. DRAWN ORDER Prize Money: 1st-£100, 2nd-£60, 3rd-£50, 4th-£40, 5th-£30, 6th-£25 In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may compete in one section only.

Foxhunter: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6. (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2017, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with Rule 310.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round qualifying period for the 2024 second rounds is 1 May '23 - 30 April '24 (subject to revision). Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2023 are not eligible for the qualification to the 2024 Championship. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

1.20m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

In accordance with Rule 82.19, no member of British Showjumping shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
